DESCRIPTION	<ul> <li>GRIP 025 is a pigmented sealer product based on acrylic dispersions in water, which can be applied by brush or roller.</li> <li>Its special formulation allows high filling power and masking of imperfections of the surface to be obtained, to restore 'the plaster effect'.</li> <li>It is also suitable for operation on plasterboard sheets in the event that a plaster effect finish be requested.</li> <li>GRIP 025 has been found to be a suitable undercoat for spatula-applied coatings. It is also recommended for smoothing walls with micro-cracks.</li> </ul>
INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE	<ul> <li>May be applied on:</li> <li>New and old plasters based on hydraulic binders.</li> <li>Gypsum and gypsumboard surfaces.</li> <li>Old paints and wall coatings that are organic or mineral in nature, dry, compact, absorbent and cohesive.</li> <li>Mineral conglomerates of various kinds, as long as they are absorbent.</li> <li>May not be used as a primer for mineral cycles (lime and silicates).</li> <li>Surfaces should be adequately prepared by following the instructions given in the paragraph 'PREPARING THE SURFACE'.</li> <li>Do not apply on freshly painted surfaces.</li> </ul>

	4810222, and with COMBAT 333 reconstruction code 4810333. - Brush or wash to remove any efflorescence and any old peeling paint. Completely eliminate any raised layers of lime-based or tempera paints. - Remove any dust, smog or other deposits by brushing.
	<ul> <li>Plaster surfaces:</li> <li>Indoors, level any irregularities in the surface and treat holes, cracks, crevices and gaps with TAMSTUCCO 9400006/9410110; Seal any cracks with STUCCOFACILE 9560019 or adequate sealants.</li> <li>Sand putty and touch-ups with sandpaper.</li> <li>Smooth if necessary with RASAMIX 9440160 or with BETOMARC 9450150 or RASOMARC 9500150 according to the type of support.</li> <li>With powdery surfaces, or in the event of high unhomogeneity of the surfaces, apply before a coat of ATOMO 8840001 micronized solvent-free fixative.</li> <li>On a clean, dry surface apply GRIP 025 following the instruction sections</li> </ul>
	Gypsum and gypsumboard surfaces: - Indoors, level any irregularities in the surface and treat holes, cracks, crevices and gaps with TAMSTUCCO 9400006/9410110; Seal any cracks with STUCCOFACILE 9560019 or adequate sealants. - Sand putty and touch-ups with sandpaper. - Smooth if necessary with RASAMIX 9440160 or with BETOMARC 9450150 or RASOMARC 9500150 according to the type of support.
